## Year 11 Summer Examinations

Dear Parent/Carer,

As previously communicated, now that the exam period has started we are writing to you to outline changes to the timetable for Year 11 from the middle of next week.

Students will be expected to attend all lessons as normal until Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup> May. On Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> May, all students will be on site for their English Literature exam. Following the completion of this exam and until the end of the exam period, students will only be expected to be on site to:

- Attend an Exam
- Attend lessons where they have a remaining exam
- Attend a revision session (departmental invitations)

There are Science and Computer Science exams on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> May, but no exams on Friday 26<sup>th</sup> May. Departments may invite students in for revision sessions where lessons are not timetabled. Students should only attend revision sessions where departments have officially invited them into school.

If students are not on school site for any of the reasons above, they will be expected to be off-site, completing independent study and revision. When students are on site for a timetabled lesson or a revision session, they are required to be in that lesson only with the designated member of staff, for attendance and safeguarding purposes.

The attached timetable covers the exam period after half term and highlights where students should be on site for lessons.

- Red font - lesson is not taking place
- Red highlight- no lessons are taking place
- Black font- lesson is taking place as normal
- Blue highlight - all students in a core exam

We would like to congratulate all of our Year 11 students on the amazing start they have made to their exams. We encourage them to continue their hard work; it really will be worth it on results day. Results will be available to collect from the school hall from **9:00-11:00am on Thursday 24th August**. If students are unable to collect their results on the day, please let the school know in advance and we can ensure results are posted to your home address.

Next month, we will write to you again regarding the arrangements for the Year 11 celebration assembly and prom.
